Auchencairn turbines will:

- Spoil the beauty of the Thornhill Scenic Area and chase away tourists. VisitScotland surveys show visitors come here for the natural scenery. Is a turbine natural?
- Contribute to a new wind farm landscape with hundreds of turbines stretching from Dalswinton to Abington in Lanakshire.
